Saint-Estèphe

Surface area:

1,78 ha

Terroir:

Limestone (Clay-chalk)

Vineyard:

Average age 45 years. Mechanical soilwork. Green harvest, deleafing

Assemblage:

52% merlot, 38% cabernet sauvignon, 10% cabernet franc

Winemaking process:

Full grain fermentation in small tanks. Pumping over and treading

Ageing:

12 months 1/3 in new oak barrel

Tasting:

It has distinctive, somewhat complex bouquet of mild tobacco, blackcurrant and small dark berries. It has a heavy savory of slightly creamy red fruits and dense silky tannins. The body is voluptuous and velvety and a mixture of both dense and mild tannins touch
