**Appellation :**  
Saint-Estèphe

**Surface area :**  
1,78 ha

**Terroir :**  
Limestone (Clay-chalk)

**Vineyard :**  
Average age 45 years. Mechanical soilwork.  
Green harvest, deleafing

**Assemblage :**  
52% merlot, 38% cabernet sauvignon,  
10% cabernet franc

**Winemaking process :**  
Full grain fermentation in small tanks. Pumping  
over and treading

**Ageing :**  
12 months  
1/3 in new oak barrel

**Tasting :**  
It has distinctive, somewhat complex bouquet of mild tobacco, blackcurrant and small dark berries. It has a heavy savory of slightly creamy red fruits and dense silky tannins. The body is voluptuous and velvety and a mixture of both dense and mild tannins touch
