Terroir :

Clay slopes on a limestone bedrock

Vineyard :

Under organic conversion since 2020

Poussard Guyot pruning, traditional ploughing with sowing of cereals and legumes, integrated farming

Assemblage :

93% sauvignon blanc, 7% sauvignon gris

Winemaking process :

Slow cold pneumatic pressing and settling

Ageing :

9 months in oak barrels, tank and stainless steel tanks on lees with regular stirring

Tasting :

Delicate aromas of spring flowers, fullbodied, lively and persistent in mouth
