Appellation :

Pessac-Léognan

Surface area :

22 ha

Terroir :

Gravelly hilltop, clay on limestone bedrock, sandy clay area

Vineyard :

Under organic conversion since 2020
Poussard Guyot pruning, traditional ploughing with sowing of cereals and legumes, integrated farming

Assemblage :

68% merlot, 32% cabernet sauvignon

Winemaking process :

Debudding, leaf thinning, treading, manual punching down, reasoning pumping over

Ageing :

12 months including 30% in fre oak barrels and 70% in stainless steel vats

Tasting :

Aromas of ripe red fruit and violet, jammy fruit and underwood in mouth, well balanced and finesse
